In Zweig's view, Balzac set out to emulate his childhood hero Napoleon. Writing 20 hours a day, Balzac's literary ambition was "tantamount to monomania in its persistence, its intensity, and its concentration." The ideal of middle-class respectability suffuses Dickens' fiction. Dostoevsky drew on the struggles of his own life to illuminate the contradictions of the human soul. In Zweig's view, his heroes had no desire to be citizens or ordinary human beings. While Balzac's heroes "would gladly have subjugated the world, Dostoevsky's heroes wished to transcend it."
